Breakthroughs

In 2004, Happy Singh was introduced to alcohol, which opened the doors to addiction. At age 17, Happy then started drinking daily while also abusing cocaine, ecstasy, molly (a pure form of MDMA) and marijuana. Due to high consumptions of drugs, bad decisions caused Happy Singh to get in trouble with the law, time and time again. At one point of his life he was on 3 different types of probations and faced a 10-year sentence. Having to hire elite lawyers, Happy Singh only did a fraction of his sentence. At age 23, Happy Singh then was introduced to Methamphetamine making it his darkest times and was unable to stop. Happy was constantly in the ER due to hypertension, anxiety, and paranoia.

On April 22, 2016, Happy Singh decided to “cold turkey” all of his addictions. He realized that he did not want to live a life of dependency towards substances. After experiencing a majestic and spiritual encounter with Jesus Christ, Happy promised to start living a sober life.

Present

Happy Singh has now decided to use his platform in the entertainment world to guide and show the new generations how to live in sobriety while having fun and always making good choices. He continues to impact many people and has decided to bring awareness about drug abuse and Gods love for the world.
